

Plants help organisations succeed!

- Solving Sick Building Syndrome

Most people would agree that organisations have to work harder today than ever before to succeed. So against such a backdrop some might be surprised to learn that plants can help organisations achieve their goals.

Because plants literally create a healthier environment workers are more productive, have less absence and are more imaginative meaning that far from being an extravagance having a number of plants around the office is very cost effective.

Air purifiers –

Dr. Billy C Wolverton who has been studying the beneficial effects of plants in buildings for over 2 decades discovered that plants absorb harmful chemicals from the air and suck these chemicals down to their roots – where they are transformed into food.

Building efficiency where windows are often sealed are particularly prone to Sick Building Syndrome – the air becomes stale. This leads to an increase in employee sickness – caused by eye, lung and respiratory problems as well as allergies colds and viruses.

Plants in the office will help clean the air making people feel healthier.

Humidity

When the humidity is right we do not notice, but too dry and people feel unwell colds and flu become more prevalent – too damp and sickness levels will increase as mould becomes a problem and dust mites multiply rapidly.

Plants can regulate the office atmosphere by either absorbing or releasing humidity.

Stress reduced

Over the last few years' people have become more aware of their work surroundings and creating the right environment in every sense. When people work in a pleasant location they feel better in themselves and are healthier, but that is of little surprise to people who work in the plants business.

Creativity increased

In experiments contrasting people solving problems in an environment with and without plants it was found that when plants were present that people came up with more creative ideas than when there were no plants.

Shopping

People prefer to shop where plants and trees make up the retail environment – and purchase more than in areas, which do not have vegetation.



Hotels

Hotels with intelligent planting schemes report higher occupancy rates after installing plants.

Reduced noise

Plants can absorb background noise, which makes for a calmer more relaxing environment.
